

Survey Constructs




- Sent to tripcentral.ca past customers and weekly email list
- Skewed towards Ontario and Atlantic Canada
- tripcentral.ca is mass market, leisure travel focused
- Heavy skew towards packaged vacations
- Unscientific poll
- Intentionally anonymous (no demographic data attributed)
- 5,785 completed surveys between February 24 to 28, 2021


Q1: It is expected that all Canadians who want to be vaccinated will be completed by September. When do <u>YOU</u> expect to be vaccinated?



Q2: How would <u>YOU</u> being vaccinated affect your decision to book travel?






Q4: Rank your concerns about booking travel - "1" being the highest concern...

Expectations of Vaccinations

- 2/3 of sample expect to be vaccinated by September, per the Government rollout plan
- 80% of those who want a vaccination expect to have it by September
- 17.42% of sample is not interested in getting vaccinated



1,008 not interested in being vaccinated

- 47% say not being vaccinated will
 NOT stop them from booking travel
- 33% say they very likely would book in May or June
- 11% say they might book in May or June
- Quarantine on return is #1 concern for 68%
- Having to get tested prior to a flight is 2nd at 21%

- #2 concern #1 choice is having to get tested before a flight 60%
- 47% so badly want to travel, you have no idea; 33% very interested
- Government restrictions are holding this group back
- 61% said "I'd go away now if there were no restrictions"
- All inclusive vacation #1 at 63%; Visit Friends & Relatives #2 at 27%

3,362 will book now, or if confident of being vaccinated, or if vaccinated

- Over 80% expect to be vaccinated by September
- Not being vaccinated themselves is the #1 concern at 45%
- Quarantine on Return ranks second as the #1 concern at 30%
- 2nd highest concern is people in destination not being vaccinated yet
 23%
- 2nd ranking 2nd concern is family and friends not being vaccinated 20%
- 70% of this group would like to travel in 2021 or winter 2022
 - Spring '21- 2.5%, Summer 6.7%, Fall 30%, Winter '22 29%
- Even after being vaccinated, a sizeable percentage of people have concerns about their destination and their friends and family

1,125 who think everyone should be vaccinated before booking any travel

- 85% believe they will be vaccinated by September
- If by May or June, hospitalizations and death rates were dramatically lower,
 68% of this group would still wait for everyone to be vaccinated before booking anything
- 12% said they might book something if things looked better in May / June
- 40% of this group cited people in destination not being vaccinated and their own vaccination as their first concern

- 51% of this group are very interested or so badly want to travel
- 27% said they can wait, and 19% said they were in no hurry to travel
- 35% think they will travel in Winter '22, 16% Fall '21
- 26% think they will travel later in
 2022 and 9% in 2023



Types of Travel Demand



- All inclusive vacations were #1 for 60% who think they will travel Fall & Winter
- Fall and Winter people chose cruise 12% for 1st choice
- Europe as 1st choice (n=427) chose Fall
 25%, and later in 2022 for 19%
- Cruise as their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd choice (n=958), only 7% thought they would travel in Spring / Summer '21. 25% chose fall '21, 27% winter '22, and 12% later in '22

Conclusions

- tripcentral.ca customers are mostly confident about vaccine rollout
- If vaccines rollout according to plans:
 - Small demand for bookings in the spring if case / hospitalizations on track
 - Bookings will begin slowly for fall and winter travel after people are vaccinated themselves; confident of being vaccinated in the coming months
 - A sizeable group will wait until friends & family or everyone is vaccinated indicating much more booking activity in the fall
 - Demand will not fully recover until our destinations are vaccinated and / or restrictions are lifted
- Those not interested in the vaccine are mostly not travelling due to restrictions
- There is strong desire to book travel and "pent up demand"
